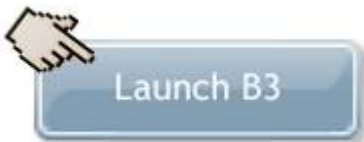

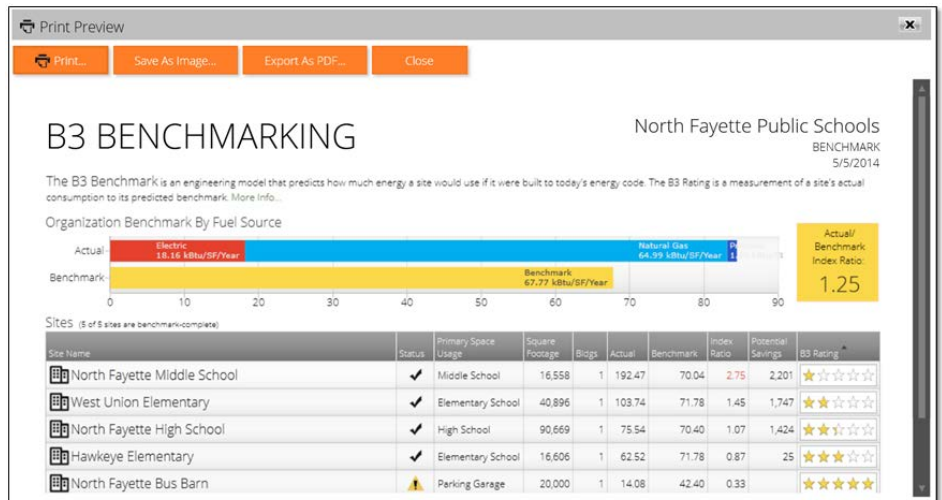
If the building or site has been decommissioned or demolished, please create a new building version indicating this. The "Create Building Versions"

B3 Software Updates

Always looking to improve, we have recently developed the following features in the B3 application:

- Mark appropriate sites with '**Site contains no water meters**' in the Site Editor
- Archive **energy documents** in the Improvements tab
- **Completeness** metric in the Reports gives immediate feedback on data quality
- Investigate **financing and support programs** on the Improvements tab
- New Target Baseline on the Reports tab helps you **assess the before and after** performance for buildings that have improvement targets
- **Site-level access** allows users to gain view or edit access to individual Sites within an Organization

Improvement Report - What do you think?

The Improvement Report arrived via email to data owners and is available on the Improvements tab. This snapshot of your organization's energy performance, which will be archived in the application over time like a bank statement, is designed to help you identify specific sites for improvements based on Benchmark and Baseline analysis.
